

KASHI VISHVANATH TEMPLE



Kashi Vishwanath temple is one of the most famous Hindu temple in the country and it is dedicated to lord Shiva, who is worshipped here as "Kashi Vishwanath" or ruler of Kashi & universe. This temple comes under the twelve jyotirlinga's, twelve holiest Shiva temples in the world.

Kaal Bhairav Mandir Is Dedicated To Fierce, Protector Form Of Shiva Known As Bhairav (kaal Bhairav), it Is Believed That Without Visiting Kal Bhairava Who Is Protector Of Kashi, Kashi Yatra Is Unfinished, The Word "Kaal" Means Both "Death" And "Fate". Saint Tulsidas Himself.



Parvati. Also Known As Annapurna (anna Means Food And Purna Means Complete Or Full) Is A Goddess Of Varanasi City Also Know As (kashi Puradishwari) Queen Of Kashi City and Consort of Kashi Vishwanath the Main Residing Deity of Kashi.

"Vishalakshi means godess with large & beautiful eye's . An aspect of godess Parvati (Gauri) . Vishalakshi temple is the only shaktipith of kashi where it is believed that eye of godess sati have fallen here which makes this temple one of





the most profound Shakti or Devi temple of the country which comes among 51 Shakti pitha's where 51 part's of Devi's body Have fallen & 51 Shakti pitha's established in various parts of India.

Kashi being spiritual capital of Bharat (India) has attracted Yogi's & devotees from all parts of India, also Varanasi has produced hundreds of spiritual masters who were born here in Kashi . Such as famous poet Saint Kabir, sant Ravi das,

aghori kinnaram baba (who re-established aghora path), trailang swami (the walking Shiva of Varanasi who lived more then 330 year's & performed many miracles infront of thousands of people) ,Shree Lahari mahasaya the famous kriya yogi who met immortal mahaavtar babaji, also kashi is the only city where four Jain tirthankar's were born ,kashi is also a place where Buddha gave his first teaching at Sarnath.

HIDDEN MYSTICAL TEMPLES OF KASHI



Apart from Kashi Vishwanath & other popular temples, Kashi also has thousands of hidden yet very powerful and concecrated shrine's, which can be found hidden in some ancient house or some narrow gali's

or hidden in some corner, 50-100 meters below ground level (Kashi has thousands of hidden temples which can be found way below ground level or hidden in most unexpected way due to Islamic invention & terror) exploring such hidden gems and meditating at such mystical & less explored shrines is very profound spiritual experience.

DELICIOUS STREET FOOD OF VARANASI



Varanasi is renowned for its street food, which includes various kinds of chat's (spicy snacks), all kinds of lassi (yogurt drink), maliyo (famous butter of Banaras), diffrent kinds of sweets such as barfi, peda, ras malai, etc also after delicious treat, Kashi people likes to eat "Banarasi pan" (flavoured betal leaf) which is world famous.
